Dear Parish Family,

Core Pillars of our Pastoral Direction: God has called us to be a church at this place and time for a purpose. Occasionally, it is important to remind ourselves of that purpose and to continue to work together fruitfully towards our mission. Our Lady of the Assumption Parish is anchored in the following 4 important pillars: **Welcome, Encounter, Grow and Share.**

Welcome: Christ came to welcome all humanity into the Kingdom of God, as a Church we should all be welcoming to everyone. We must consciously demonstrate hospitable attitudes and invite others to our church to meet Jesus.

Encounter: Jesus became man so that all humanity may come to encounter God in him. He is the Emmanuel – God with us. By the Incarnation God showed us that he is not distant from us but close to us. We are able to learn from Christ who is the way, the truth and the life and are nourished to grow in his love, faith and service. All the liturgies we celebrate and the sacraments, primarily the Mass is one sure way we encounter Christ who comes to us in his body and blood. As a parish we need to strive for a deeper encounter and relationship with Jesus. Moreover, all we do at our parish must bring others to know Jesus and to build a strong relationship with him.

Grow: The parable of the mustard seed (Matthew 13:31-32) is a huge reminder that our lives with God must be open to growth. As parish family, we need to ensure that we are growing in our love for God and others, our understanding of the faith, our service to others and our spirituality in general. Anyone who attends our church should examine and work on growing in the faith through all the pastoral services we provide and their own personal commitment to learning more about the faith and putting it into practice. Our Catholic faith is not just a mere philosophy; it is a practical and meaningful relationship with God lived with Christ as our model.

Share: Jesus shared his life with us for our wellbeing and salvation. As followers of Christ, we are called to do same, to share our gifts and resources in fostering the work of God, in growing our parish community and serving the poor and the needy.

I would like to humbly urge you to prayerfully consider these Pillars of our pastoral direction. Let us all work together towards their fulfilment. No one should be left behind; everyone must get involved.

The 4 pillars are now boldly written at the top of our main entrance to the church. We Thank Mrs. Elena Minicucci (Chairperson of the Parish Pastoral Council) and her family, for donating to support this initiative.

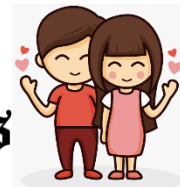
