



75th Anniversary Year: This year presents us with a wonderful opportunity to celebrate our Parish's 75th year of establishment. I invite you to participate actively in the programs lined up. Purchase our anniversary paraphernalia and cookbook, get tickets for our Gala, share in our Parish Family Photo Book, donate to support our anniversary fundraising, learn our anniversary song, plan to attend the climax Mass and most importantly pray for our parish. May we all have a fruitful 75th Parish Anniversary.

Installation of the 10th Bishop of Hamilton: His Excellency, Bishop Joseph Dabrowski, will be installed as the 10th Bishop of Hamilton on Monday, February 2, at 11:00 a.m. at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King in Hamilton. This is an invitation-only liturgical celebration. For those unable to attend in person, the Mass will be livestreamed (Check diocesan website for the link), allowing the wider diocesan community to participate prayerfully from home. I kindly ask you to keep our new Bishop in prayer as he begins his episcopal ministry among us, asking that he be warmly welcomed and supported in this new chapter of service.

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord: Monday February 2, is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, commemorating the presentation of the infant Jesus in the Temple of Jerusalem by Mary and Joseph, 40 days after Christmas, fulfilling Jewish laws regarding the firstborn. It also marks Mary's ritual purification, the encounter with Simeon and Anna, and Jesus as the "Light to the Gentiles". Based on Luke 2:22-40, it celebrates the moment Simeon recognized Jesus as the Messiah, prophesying him as a light for revelation. This feast is often called Candlemas, the day involves the blessing of candles, which are carried in procession to symbolize Christ as the "Light of the World". Be reminded to bring candles for blessing, also light a votive candle at the back of the church to pray for yourself and loved ones.


