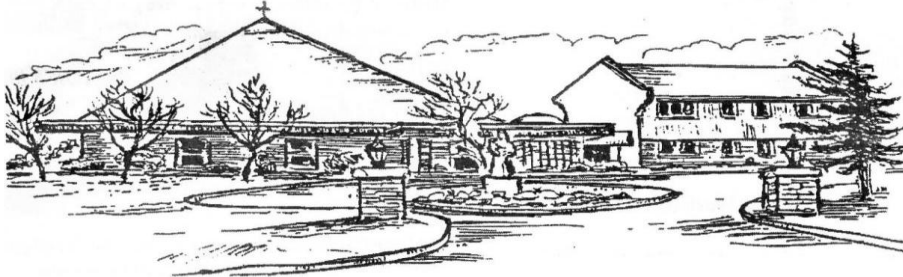

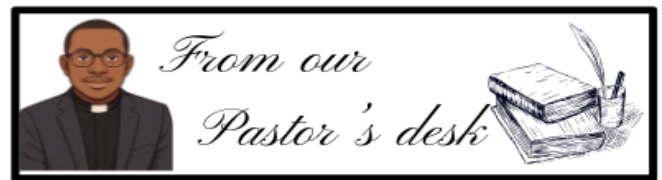

World Day of the Sick: February 11 marks world day of the sick. This celebration highlights Jesus' healing ministry in the life of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. Jesus is always close to the sick, shares in their suffering and desires their healing. We also recognize the great work of doctors, nurses, health care personnels, and pastoral care givers in supporting and restoring those afflicted with illness and disease. We shall celebrate **Mass of anointing of the sick on Tuesday 10TH February**, for all those in need of Healing. This anointing is for ONLY BAPTIZED CATHOLICS as it is a SACRAMENT.

Season of Lent: begins this month with Ash Wednesday on **February 18**. Take note of Ash Wednesday Masses, Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 7pm, omission of *Alleluia and Gloria*, fasting, almsgiving, prayer, abstinence from meat on Fridays, Palm Sunday celebration, Chrism Mass, and Holy Triduum (the one continued Mass from Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and ending with Holy Saturday with Easter Sunday inclusive.) This Lent we shall collect non-perishable goods for food banks in Hamilton to assist those in need.
